Affirmations with children builds lifelong resilience

It is so easy for us to think negatively. We all from time to time find ourselves in a negative thinking spiral when we are in stressful situations or environments throughout our lives.

It is healthy and essential for your child to identify and express their emotions, but it is not helpful to stay stuck in them for extended periods.

Thanks to a concept know as neuroplasticity, new neuropathways in the brain are created every time your child puts intention into their thoughts.

We can redirect our thoughts with a more **positive thought** to replace the negative one and repeat it several times to oneself, creating a new neuro pathway. The more you practice intentional positive thoughts, the easier it becomes. Below are some positive thoughts to motivate you for the week.

Order of Operations BEDMAS


В	Brackets, ()
